Fees are adjusted on a sliding scale according to family size and income. The fee is determined when users register and is updated annually. Proof of Medicaid, Medicare and Private Insurances must be presented at time of registration; Documentation of eligibility for sliding fee schedule is verified by providing proof of income (W-2 or last three pay stubs for primary wage earners), picture ID with current address, proof of address (utility bill with current address), and Social Security numbers for all family members if patients (if available); other documentation may be required.
